Dear Student,

Thank you for applying to our waitlist to live on campus starting Fall 2023. We are reaching out to share updates.

The current project schedule for Theatre District Living and Learning Neighborhood shows that Building 5, that includes housing, academic space for the new provost as well as the general assignment classrooms will be available in September. The remainder of beds are anticipated to open during Winter Quarter 2024. All beds in Building 5 will be allocated to incoming Eighth College students. For this reason, students currently on the Fall Quarter 2023 waitlist may need to consider off-campus housing options.

Reason for Delay

One innovative approach UC San Diego takes advantage of to reduce construction impacts is prefabricating interior and exterior wall panels. This reduces on-site noise, traffic and parking, while also reducing waste and improving quality and safety. The primary driver of the delay is a delay in receiving these prefabricated materials, but supply chain issues and an extreme amount of rain also contributed.

Available Housing Options for Winter and Spring Quarters 2024

Students who have flexibility for their fall living arrangements and would like to live on campus for winter and spring quarters will need to submit their interest on the <u>Undergraduate Housing Waitlist</u>. Contracts for Winter and Spring Quarters 2024 will be issued starting the week of May 22, 2023 based on a student's position on the waitlist.
